2. The Terms of Reference (ToRs) are:

- i. The Committee shall visit the provinces and hold meetings with the provincial stakeholders in order to ensure that:
- a. The procurement targets for wheat for year 2021-22 are timely achieved.
- b. Measures to prevent hoarding of wheat, wheat flour, and sugar are implemented.
- c. Price of wheat remains stable and wheat flour is available at a price not exceeding Rs. 490/10 kg across the country through provision of appropriate subsidy.
- d. Release of procured wheat by the provinces are handled in an efficient and well coordinated manner to keep the price of wheat flour stable.
- e. Releases of procured wheat by PASSCO to Utility Stores Corporation are made on a timely basis.
- f. Measures for ensuring price stability of sugar are implemented.
- g. Any other related issue(s) is/are resolved.

ii. The Chairman shall brief the Prime Minister, at least fortnightly, about the overall progress on implementation.
