2. ToRs of the Coordination Committee are as follows:—

The committee will:

- Nominate a focal person to interact with provincial governments
- Interact with provincial governments to collect updated data / information on educational damages and evolve/consolidate the data sheet

regularly, mainly facilitated by PIE on standard templates

- iii. Keep constant contact and discussion with provincial governments to ask for their specific needs for flood response and recovery, rehabilitation and safe reopening of schools, and compile the summary with the main technical assistance of PIE
- iv. Share consolidated summaries at serial (i) and (ii) with M/o FEPT and Development Partners at regular intervals for facilitating further response planning
- v. Where possible, one or two members of the committee may visit field to zoom-in on the ground facts for adding to the information on flood damage and recovery needs that can contribute to the flood response plan development by the M/o FEPT, Development Partners and Provinces
- vi. Debrief the senior management of the M/o FEPT and Development Partners about the floods' recovery efforts in the provinces through continuous contact and consultation with the provincial governments.
- vii. Work closely with development partners and Provincial Governments to re-align the ongoing programs for expeditious response to flood / rain emergencies.
- viii. Develop practical proposals regarding establishment of Temporary Learning Centers (TLCs), mobile schools, provision of learning materials, reconstruction of schools and provision of psycho-social supports for students and communities.
- ix. Make dedicated efforts to include private sector philanthropy for educational purposes.
- x. Establish robust data collection system and analytics for policy support.
