2. The TORs of the Committee shall be to:
- i Evaluate the effectiveness and relevance of foreign study tours (FST) in enhancing the exposure and competencies of senior civil servants.
 - ii Based on past evaluations (if any), examine the extent to which the FST help the participants in applying the international best practices within their respective domains, including mechanism for post-tour knowledge dissemination.
 - iii Assess the financial, intellectual, and operational returns of foreign study tours, with a focus on long-term capacity building and improved service delivery.
 - iv Compare foreign study tour models within the country such as NDU.
 - v In the light of above analysis, undertake a cost-benefit analysis and give structured recommendation as to whether the module/component of foreign study tour may be revived or otherwise. If the answer is in affirmative, the format, structure and post visit training activities may be suggested for the implementation by the NSPP.
 - vi Any other matter incidental or related to the above ToRs.

5. The Committee shall complete its task within 07 days and furnish a report for perusal of the Prime Minister.
