*further to amend the National Database and Registration Authority
Ordinance, 2000*

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the National Database and Registration Authority Ordinance, 2000 (VIII of 2000) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Senate and the National Assembly are not in session and the President of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Ordinance shall be called the National Database and Registration Authority (Amendment) Ordinance, 2021.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 7, Ordinance VIII of 2000.**—In the National Database and Registration Authority Ordinance, 2000 (VIII of 2000), in section 7, after sub-section (3), the following new sub-sections shall be added, namely:—

“(4) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law for the time being in force or in any agreement or instrument whatsoever, every user and feeder agency shall promptly provide data to the Authority as specified and required by it for the purposes of this Ordinance.

(5) Whoever contravenes the provisions of sub-section (4) shall be guilty of misconduct and liable for action under the relevant law upon a complaint made to the Authority”.
