TORs of National Policy Working Group for Post Crash

- (1) develop recommendations and timelines for implementation of the recommendations within the *Guidelines for Post-Crash Response*

- (2) develop a policy framework to inform the development of the model Road Safety Act, with particular reference to Chapter 5 ("Post-Crash Response).
- (3) consider the need for post-crash response Rules to be made under the proposed Road Safety Act, taking into consideration the circumstances of each jurisdiction.
- (4) review and harmonise the processes for collection and analysis of pre-hospital and emergency hospital data from road traffic accidents to ensure that policies can be based on data and information.
- (5) identify the steps which will need to be taken to implement the proposed reforms in each province and federal territory.
- (6) identify required training and capacity building to improve the quality standard of pre-hospital and emergency hospital care across Pakistan.
- (7) any other recommendations of the Policy Working Group.
