He remained absent from duty with effect from 10/07/2024 till 07/10/2024 without any intimation/pre-sanctioned leave. CMA (RC), Rawalpindi issued explanation / directives vide letter dated 11/07/2024 for resumption of his duty followed by reminders dated 24/07/2024, 09/08/2024 & 30/08/2024, but he neither responded to the official communication nor reported for duty.
- ii.

Minor penalty of “**withholding of one increment for one year**” on the scale charge of unauthorized absence (**127 days**) was earlier imposed upon him vide this office order No. 959/AN/341/RC/25340, dated 27/06/2024 and his conduct was placed under observation for one year, but no improvement in his conduct has been noticed and he absented himself again as mentioned above.

2. Show Cause Notice dated 07/10/2024 was served upon the accused official vide CM (RC) letter dated 11/10/2024. The above named accused official submitted his reply to Show Cause Notice dated **04/11/2024**. CMA (RC) furnished Parawise comments upon his reply vide their letter dated, 15/11/2024.

3. In order to meet the norms of justice the accused official was afforded an opportunity of personal hearing by the Military Accountant General being “Authority” on **04/12/2024**. The accused official appeared before the Authority on due date and time fixed for the personal hearing but could not justify his absence. He took the stance during personal hearing that being a Gazetted Employee he sanctioned his own leave exercising the powers of the Federal Government. He was informed that as per Revised Leave Rules (which he quoted), sanction of the Competent Authority for any kind of leave is necessary and no one can approve/sanction his/her own leave. However, he appeared perplexed and was not able to appreciate the spirit of rule. He seemed confused and unfit for further Government Service as After spending more than 27 years, he could not understand the basics of the rules.

4. His service record also reveals that he had been penalized multiple times for misconduct and unauthorized absence as follows:-
