Notice of Initiation of Anti-Dumping Investigation on Alleged Dumped Imports of Paint Brush Filaments Originating in and/or Exported from the People's Republic of China into Pakistan

A. D. C. No. 63/2023/NTC/PBF.—National Tariff Commission (the “Commission”) has received an application on December 01, 2023 under Section 20 of Anti-Dumping Duties Act, 2015 (the “Act”) from M/s Universal Brushwares (Pvt.) Limited, Karachi (the “Applicant”). The Applicant is a producer of Paint Brush Filaments. The Applicant has alleged that Paint Brush Filaments are being exported to Pakistan at dumped prices from the People's Republic of China (“China”), which has caused and is causing injury within the meaning of the Act to the domestic industry producing domestic like product.

Upon initial examination, assessing accuracy and adequacy of the evidence/information provided in application in accordance with Section 23 of the Act, the Commission is satisfied that the evidence and information provided in the application is sufficient to justify initiation of an investigation.

Initiation of Investigation: The Commission hereby initiates an investigation pursuant to Section 23 of the Act. The investigation will determine whether Paint Brush Filaments originating in and/or exported from China are dumped into Pakistan and whether such dumping has caused and /or threaten to cause injury to the domestic industry within the meaning of provisions of the Act. The Commission, during course of this investigation, will call further information/data from the interested parties deemed necessary for the purposes of this Investigation.

Product under Investigation: The product allegedly being dumped into Pakistan is Paint Brush Filaments (the "investigated product"). The investigated product is classified under Pakistan Customs Tariff ("PCT") Heading Nos 5404.1900 and 5404.9000. However, the Applicant has stated that the investigated product is also imported under PCT 5406.0000. Therefore, this aspect will also be investigated and will be determined during the investigation, whether investigated product falls under PCT No. 5406.0000. Interested parties are encouraged to assist the Commission in this regard. The Investigated product is used in manufacturing of paint brushes.

Period of Investigation (POI): For determination of dumping and injury, the POI is as follows:

For determination of dumping:	From October 01, 2022, to September 30, 2023
For determination of injury:	From January 01, 2022, to September 30, 2023

All interested parties are invited to make their views/comments known to the Commission and to submit information and documents (if any) not later than 45 days of the date of publication of this notice in the press in Pakistan. All written submissions provided by interested parties on a confidential basis must be marked "Confidential" and in accordance with Section 31 of the Act, shall be accompanied by a non-confidential version/summary which will be placed in the public file.
