S. R. O. 287(I)/2022.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the China Pakistan Economic Corridor Authority Act, 2021 (V of 2021), the Federal Government is pleased to direct that the following amendments shall be made in China Pakistan Economic Corridor Authority (Terms and Conditions of Appointment of Members) Rules, 2020, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

(i) in rule 2,—

(a) the existing clauses (a) and (b) shall be renumbered as clauses (b) and (a) respectively and for clause (a), renumbered as aforesaid, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(a) “Act” means the China Pakistan Economic Corridor Authority Act, 2021 (Act No. V of 2021);” and

(b) in sub-rule (2), for the word “Ordinance” the word “Act” shall be substituted.

(ii) in rule 3,—

(a) for sub-rule (1), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) There shall be six Members of the Authority, who shall be appointed under the Act:

Provided that the person so appointed as Member shall cease to hold the post on completion of term of appointment or on attaining age of sixty-five years, whichever is earlier.”; and

(b) in sub-rule (4), in clause (f), for the expression “6 of the Ordinance”, the expression “13 of the Act” shall be substituted.

(iii) in rule 8, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“8. **Member (Information Technology).**—No person shall be appointed as Member (Information Technology), unless he—

(a) holds an advance degree with minimum sixteen years’ education, Ph.D. in information technology, information systems, computer sciences, software engineering or any other relevant field from a reputed national or international university or institute recognized by the Higher Education Commission; and

(b) has not less than fifteen years distinguished professional career at national or international level including five to ten years of managerial experience of policy making in a relevant field in private sector or multi-national organization or in public sector in the field of information technology.”;

(iv) in rule 9, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“9. **Member (Science and Technology).**—No person shall be appointed as Member (Science & Technology), unless he—

(c) holds an advance degree with minimum sixteen years’ education, Ph.D. in biological sciences, biotechnology, life and physical sciences, natural sciences or any other relevant field from a reputed national or international university or institute recognized by the Higher Education Commission; and

- (d) has not less than fifteen years distinguished professional career at national or international level including five to ten years of managerial experience of policy making in a relevant field in private sector or multi-national organization or in public sector in the field of science and technology.”; and
- (v) in rule 12, for the word “Ordinance” the word “Act” shall be substituted.”
