**Notice of Impending Expiry of Anti-dumping Duties Levied on Imports of
Offset Printing Ink into Pakistan Originating in and/or Exported from the
People's Republic of China and the Republic of Korea**

A.D.C No 40/2015/NTC/OPI/IE.— The National Tariff Commission (the “Commission”), after making an affirmative final determination in terms of Section 39 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Act, 2015 (the “Act”) imposed definitive anti-dumping duties on dumped imports of Offset Printing Ink in the form of paste also known as paste ink or oil-based Offset Printing Ink, but does not include water based, UV based, solvent based, flexographic rotogravure and other inks in liquid, powder or solid form (“Offset Printing Ink”) falling under PCT Heading Nos. 3215.1110, 3215.1190, 3215.1910, 3215.1990 into Pakistan originating in and/or exported from the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Korea ranging from 2.16% to 17.92% of C&F value in ad val. terms till July 20, 2022.

In terms of Section 58(2) of the Act, it is hereby notified that the definitive anti-dumping duties levied on dumped imports of Offset Printing Ink originating in and/or exported from the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Korea shall terminate on July 20, 2022 unless a review under Section 58(3) of the Act is initiated before the date of termination of the duty. Domestic industry producing Offset Printing Ink may file a sunset review application with the Commission on the prescribed form within forty-five days of the publication of this notice, if it so wishes. The sunset review application form may be obtained from the Commission.
