2. The Committee will meet biannually and review the progress of overall actions at the federal & provincial levels, including the formulation and enforcement of new legislation and regulations.

3. Detailed TOR's / tasks of the Committee shall include:

- i. To ensure development of effective strategies, action plans and frameworks for implementation of the Policy;
- ii. To oversee progress on implementation activities;
- iii. To ensure monitoring and evaluation on implementing pathways;
- iv. To ensure stocktaking on progress regarding enforcement of Policy measures;
- v. To scale up national efforts, mechanisms, and control systems for effective implementation;
- vi. To conduct mid-term review of the Policy at the intervals of every one and a half year;
- vii. To recommend the findings and recommendations of mid-term review for incorporation in the Policy with approval of the competent forums;
- viii. To review and decide on the findings and recommendations of the Technical Committee on HW and Special Working Groups under it, on Environmentally Sound Management (ESM) of hazardous waste, referred by the National Implementation Committee;
- ix. Any other TOR assigned to the Committee.
