S. R. O. 1747(I)/2022.—In pursuance sub-rule-2 of Rule-3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer), Rules, (1973), and Section 7(1)(b)(i) and (ii) of FPSC Ordinance, 1977 (XLV of 1977) and in exercise of the powers conferred upon Governor, GB under Article 117 of Gilgit-Baltistan Order, 2018, the following amendments shall be made in the existing recruitment rules of Legal Advisory Service (LAS) notified *vide* SRO.943(I)/2019, dated the 5th August, 2019, namely:—

In the aforesaid recruitment rules,

- (a) In Rule-1 (Preamble), the following post/entries shall be incorporated at S.No. 13-A after S.No. 13 under the relevant columns:—

SCHEDULE-II (b)
(See Rule 4 and Schedule-1)

1. The Federal Public Service Commission shall hold Combined Competitive Examination for the post of Deputy District Attorney (BS-17). The Examination shall consist of the following two parts:
 - (a) Written Examination = 200 Marks
 - (b) Viva voce = 100 Marks
 - Grand Total = 300 Marks
2. **Qualification/Experience:**
 - a. 2nd Class or Grade “C” Bachelor’s degree in Law or equivalent qualification from a University recognized by the HEC; and
 - b. 02 years experience of practicing as a lawyer or two years experience as prosecutor on behalf of the Government.

3. **Age-Limits:**

Minimum 22 years and Maximum 33 years.

Note:—The upper age limits will be relaxed by a maximum period of 05 years in case of Government servants who have rendered at least two (2) years continuous service on closing date for receipt of application.

4. **Syllabus of Written Examination:**

The Syllabus/Paper of the written examination will be as under:—

- a. Each paper carries 100 marks and will be 03 hours duration; and
- b. A candidate may answer the paper in English.

Law-I

- a. Civil Procedure Code.
- b. Land Revenue Act.
- c. Contract Act.
- d. Sale of Goods Act.
- e. Specific Relief Act.

Law-II

- a. Qanoon-e-Shahadat.
- b. Principles of Muhammadan Law.
- c. Registration Act and Stamp Act.
- d. Limitation Act.
- e. West Pakistan Civil Code Ordinance 1962.
- f. Gilgit-Baltistan Preemption Act.

5. **Viva Voce: 100 marks**

Each candidate will be interviewed by an interviewed Board comprising of at least two Members of the Commission. The objective will be to test the personal qualities of a candidate and to assess his/her suitability for the services, his/her intelligence and alertness of mind, his/her vigor, strength of character and potential qualities of leadership.

6. **Qualifying Standard:**

- a. 33% marks in each individual paper.
- b. 50% marks in the aggregate of written portion of examination (0.50) marks or more will be rounded to (1.0); and
- c. 50% marks in viva voce.

7. **Place of Examination:** Gilgit, Skardu, Islamabad and Karachi Centre.

8. **Place of Interview:** Gilgit and Islamabad Centre.

9. **Note:** The Commission however, reserve the right to finally decide the place where the candidates would be interviewed.

10. This notification issues with the approval of Governor, Gilgit-Baltistan *vide* summary bearing No. F.2 (9)/2019-Reg-Services, dated 12-08-2021 and with the concurrence of FPSC continued *vide* its letter No. F.15-15/2020-RR, dated 25-07-2022.
